India is our mission focus for the month of May.

Witnessing Ministries of Christ is a Presbyterian sponsorship program working with the Dalit people. Dalit, meaning "broken/scattered" in Sanskrit and Hindi, is a term mostly used for the castes in India that are considered untouchable. Dalits were excluded from the four-fold Varna system of Hinduism and were seen as forming a fifth Varna, also known by the name of *Panchama*. Witnessing Ministries of Christ serves to provide the "untouchables" with education, health care, and means to help them rise above their unfortunate plight to achieve a normal life. We have been partnering with WMC for years through a relationship formed by Margaret Courtwright of our congregation. Margaret, now deceased, retired here to New Wilmington. She was a "Mission Kid" who grew up in India.


NWPC Preschool is offering a Spring Cash & Carry Usborne Book Fair.
