The 2018 New Wilmington Mission Conference will be held July 20-27 at Westminster College in New Wilmington, PA. At 113 years old, the New Wilmington Mission Conference is the longest-running mission conference in the United States. Held on the campus of Westminster College in Pennsylvania every July, NWMC is intergenerational, Presbyterian-related and youth-focused. About 800 people attend from over 30 states and 20 countries, including several Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) mission co-workers and members of the Niger and Sudan/South Sudan mission networks, for a chance to connect with mission workers and hear what God is doing all over the world. This week-long conference features many well-known and engaging speakers.

“Love Your Neighbor” (Galatians 5:14) is the theme for the 2018 Conference.

This past Palm Sunday our church presented *The Week That Shook the World*, a musical Tenebrae Service written by Karen Latta and Marion Fairman. Both are retired, Bob from Westminster College and Karen from Wilmington Area School District. They have 3 children who grew up in this church and 9 grandchildren.

TWO Summer Lunch Programs, that is!

1. This summer children through age 18 are invited to the pavilion at Heritage Hills for a hearty lunch every Tuesday and Thursday, continuing through Thursday, August 16th.

Lunch will be served from 12:00 to 1:00pm. Come a bit early to enjoy hula-hooping, football throwing, bubble-blowing and a myriad of other summer activities.

With thanks to the Pittsburgh Food Bank and LCAAP in New Castle these meals are provided free of charge. We are only able to serve children and teens. Lunch is not provided for adults, but volunteers may eat after children are served.

Volunteers are needed to deliver the meals to Heritage Hills, to serve meals, and to interact with the kids. Please sign-up to help on the bulletin board in the Ligo Room.

2. **Title-1 is a summer school program for elementary school-aged children being held from July 9 to July 25, 2018.** For the fifth year NWPC will coordinate the free lunch program for Title-1 students at the New Wilmington Elementary School, and we appreciate your past willingness to serve or transport lunches. Again this year, **volunteers are needed to either help serve lunches** from approximately 11am to 12:15pm or **to pick up the food** from Ben Franklin School in New Castle around 10:30am and **then return the empty containers** back to Ben Franklin by 1pm (no clearances required for drivers).
