Ethiopia is our mission focus for July and for great reason; NWPC supports both the work of PC(USA) Mission Co-Workers Michael and Rachel Weller and the 2019 Summer Service Team of NWMC which is in Ethiopia working with the Wellers. The

Team will be returning to Conference where you can hear them personally report on their experiences in Ethiopia.

Here is an update about the work of the Summer Service Team that we received through NWMC Director Rev. Ginny Teitt:

"For the past 3 weeks, this year's Summer Service Team has been exploring the city of Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. Each day has consisted of seeing new sights, meeting new people, and learning about the Ethiopian church and culture. The team has been working closely with the Mekane Yesus Church, teaching English and having impactful conversations. The focus of the team for this trip is building relationships with the Ethiopian people, learning from them, and sharing stories together. The team also had the opportunity to spend time at the Center for Mentally Challenged children for two weeks, learning from the teachers and connecting with the students. Currently, the team is in the Gambella region of Ethiopia, where they will spend the last two weeks with Rachel and Michael Weller, PCUSA Mission Co-Workers. While here we will be working with youth in trauma healing sessions, connecting with and learning from people in the Gambella region and the Wellers. The team is so very thankful for your continued prayers and looks forward to sharing everything they've learned during this incredible experience!"
