**Ethiopia** has been our mission focus for July and for great reason; NWPC supports both the work of PC (USA) Mission Co-Workers Michael and Rachel Weller and the 2019 Summer Service Team of New Wilmington Mission Conference which served in Ethiopia, working with the Wellers.

Here is a brief summary of the Summer Service Team trip:

*For the first 3 weeks the Summer Service Team explored the city of Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, seeing new sights, meeting new people, and learning about the Ethiopian church and culture. The team worked closely with the Mekane Yesus Church, teaching English and having impactful conversations. The team's focus was building relationships with the Ethiopian people, learning from them, and sharing stories together. The team also spent time at the Center for Mentally Challenged children for two weeks, learning from the teachers and connecting with the students. For the last two weeks, the team was in the Gambella region of Ethiopia with Rachel and Michael Weller. While there they worked with youth in trauma healing sessions, connecting with and learning from people in the Gambella region and the Wellers. The team is so very thankful for your prayers.*

#### Westminster College has announced the appointment of Dr. Andrew Withington as its new Director of Choral Activities.

Dr. Withington is a native of New Zealand, making his arrival in New Wilmington, PA, much more than the typical move. While he will be living in Gateway, and furniture is being provided, **we have the opportunity to welcome him to our neighborhood by providing other household and pantry items** that we take for granted every day, but which doesn't fit easily into suitcases for a trans-Pacific relocation!
