CARE PORTAL UPDATE April – June

Many thanks to all who have helped with Care Portal! Your contributions of money and items, purchases, furniture assembling, and delivery are greatly appreciated.

In the second quarter of 2025, the NWPC Care Portal team has provided 19 twin bed frames, 2 twin bunk bed frames, 2 crib frames, 9 twin mattresses, 2 crib mattresses, 19 twin comforters, 8 sets of twin sheets, 4 crib sheets, 8 dressers, 2 kitchen tables with chairs, and a set of pots and pans to families in need in Lawrence County. Our partnership with Neshannock Presbyterian Church in these efforts continues to grow.

Here are a few of the stories behind the numbers. They are requests NWPC has helped meet.

- Family recently secured a home after being homeless. They have two children and one disabled adult child in need of beds. Requesting 3 twin bedframes/mattresses/sheets/blankets/pillows.
- Kinship home recently took in a child removed from their biological family. In need of a twin bedframe/mattress/sheets/blanket/pillow.
- Grandmother recently took in her two grandchildren due to mother's substance abuse. Children are in need of beds/bedding. Requesting a bunkbed frame/two twin mattresses/sheets/blankets/pillows.
- Mom was homeless. Now has an apartment, but is in need of two twin bedframes/mattresses/sheets/blankets/pillows, a sofa, and a dining table and chairs.
- Family is in need of two dressers. Their clothes are currently sitting on the floor. Also requesting pots and pans.
- Children are being reunited with their mother. In need of three twin bedframes/mattresses/sheets/blankets/pillows. Also in need of two dressers and a dining room table and chairs.
- Family is moving out of a hotel and into a home. Requesting a bunk bedframe/two twin mattresses/sheets/blankets/pillows for the two boys. Also requesting a dresser for their clothing.
- Three children are currently sharing a broken bed. Requesting 3 twin bedframes/mattresses/sheets/blankets/pillows. Also requesting, at least, one dresser for the three children to share. Family is also in need of a kitchen table/chairs so the family can eat meals together.
- Grandmother took in her two granddaughters when mother entered rehab. Requesting a twin bed/mattress/sheets/blanket/pillow. Also requesting a dresser.
