ANNOUNCEMENTS

35th Wayne H. Christy Lecture will be held this evening, Sunday, November 2, 6:30 PM in Wallace Memorial Chapel. The Wayne H. Christy Memorial Lecture series honors the late **Dr. Wayne Christy**, a long-time faculty member and chair of the Department of Religion and Philosophy at Westminster College. As Dr. Christy dedicated his life to relating the heritage of faith to the emerging issues of a changing culture, the lecture series seeks out men and women who distinguish themselves by relating Christian faith to issues of contemporary life. Dr. Christy was a long time member of New Wilmington Presbyterian Church who also served in leadership roles with the New Wilmington Mission Conference.

The Rev. Dr. Stephen McConnell will serve as our speaker. Dr. McConnell is a Westminster College alumni member, Class of 1980 and a current member of the college's Board of Trustees. He has recently retired as senior pastor of Church of the Psalms Presbyterian Church in Sarasota, Florida.

This event is free and open to the public.

Stephen D. McConnell (Steve) is a fourth-generation Presbyterian pastor. He attended Westminster College (PA) and Princeton Theological Seminary. He received his Doctor of Letters from the Graduate School at Drew University concentrating on the works of C.S. Lewis. Over his forty years of ministry Steve served three congregations: the Melrose Carmel Presbyterian Church outside of Philadelphia, the Liberty Corner Presbyterian Church in Liberty Corner, New Jersey and the Church of the Palms in Sarasota, Florida, from which he recently retired. He is a member of the Board of Trustees at Westminster College in New Wilmington, PA. Steve is the author of four books, Take Me to Aslan: C. S. Lewis and the Art of Trusting, When the Wind is Against You: Encouragement for When Life Pushes Back, Safe at Home: Finding What You Never Lost and A Street Called Detour: Encouragement for When Life Changes Direction. He is married to Amanda and they have a daughter, Brittany, and two grandchildren, Brooke and Jacob.
